






Thank you so much for securing your personal belongings with LassoTag.

<p>1. To activate the LassoTag iBeacon, insert a coin into the notch at the tip of the LassoTag iBeacon and twist to open the case.</p>	
<p>2. Next, remove the yellow safety tab and close the case by squeezing the sides back together. It will make a noticeable “snap” when properly aligned. The + sign on the CR2032 battery should be UP.</p> <p>Follow these same steps for changing out the CR2032 battery in approximately 3-6 months depending on usage. <i>Batteries should be recycled or disposed of as per state & local guidelines.</i></p>	
<p>3. To activate the LassoTag USB (sold separately), simply insert it into any USB port.</p>	
<p>4. Finally, download the LassoTag App from the Apple App Store or scan this QR code.</p>	
<p>5. The first time you use your LassoTag Application, iOS8 will prompt you to “Allow LassoTag to access your location even when you are not using the app”. Click “Allow”. (See FAQ for more information.)</p> <p>6. Create a login & password or register via Facebook.</p> <p>7. The Welcome Screen will help you get set up.</p>	
<p>8. Your LassoTag Application will automatically connect to the LassoTag after 30 seconds with a default icon and TAG id. The Hot/Cold Search & Rescue Finder bar should be RED and will decrease to BLUE as the LassoTag moves away from the iPhone. (The Battery Life should be full and the Temperature Gauge should be registering.)</p> <p>Click on the icon to change its settings.</p> <p>NOTE – Up to 6 LassoTags can be connected. They will connect automatically after performing steps 1 & 2 above.</p>

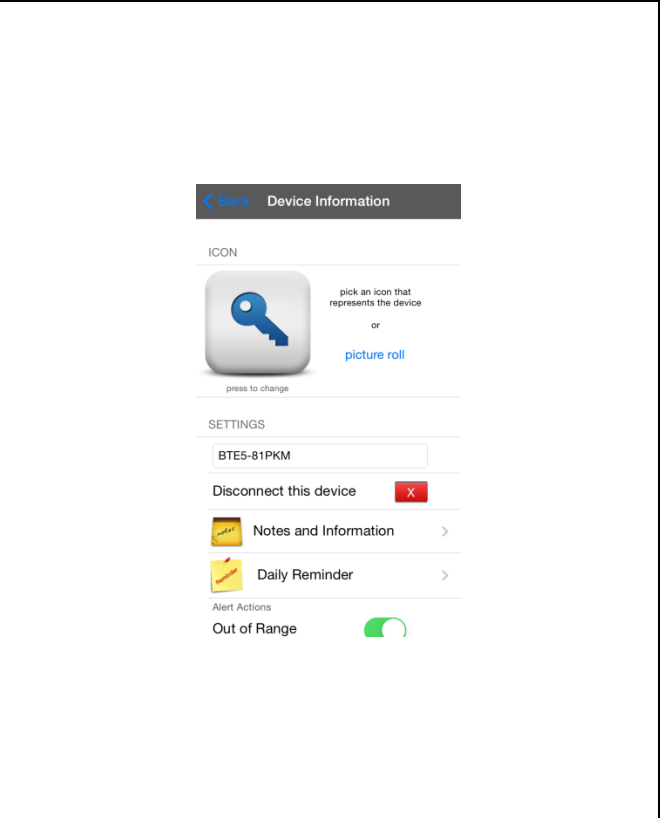

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- 9. Device Information:**
- Click on the icon to change it or click on Picture Roll to select a photo.
 - Click on Default TAG id to use a more descriptive name like “Car Keys”
 - Click on RED X to disconnect.
 - Click on Notes to store additional details about your belongings.
 - Toggle Alert Actions to be notified when LassoTag is; Out of Range or Connecting.
 - *(Moving is for LassoTag HD only and disabled for LassoTag iBeacon)*
 - Toggle Audio to turn Audio Alerts on and off.
 - Click on Audio Alert Sound to customize the Audio Alert.
 - Toggle Checkin Alert to get SMS text messages when LassoTag has not connected for 1 hour.
 - Toggle Disconnected Notice to get SMS text and phone calls. (\$)
 - *(Phone numbers must be set in the Settings menu from the Main menu for this option to function properly.)*
 - Use the Map to see the last location where the LassoTag was connected.



10. Use the Double Sided Tape (included) to attach your LassoTag to any valuable.

What is the Premium Service?

When the LassoTag Beacon leaves your radius you will receive a **FREE** Audio/Visual Notification from the LassoTag application. If the LassoTag Beacon is not back in range within 2 minutes, the LassoTag System will escalate and you will receive a Text message. If there is still no response to the lost LassoTag Beacon, the system will call you. (The Premium Service can notify up to 3 phone numbers.)

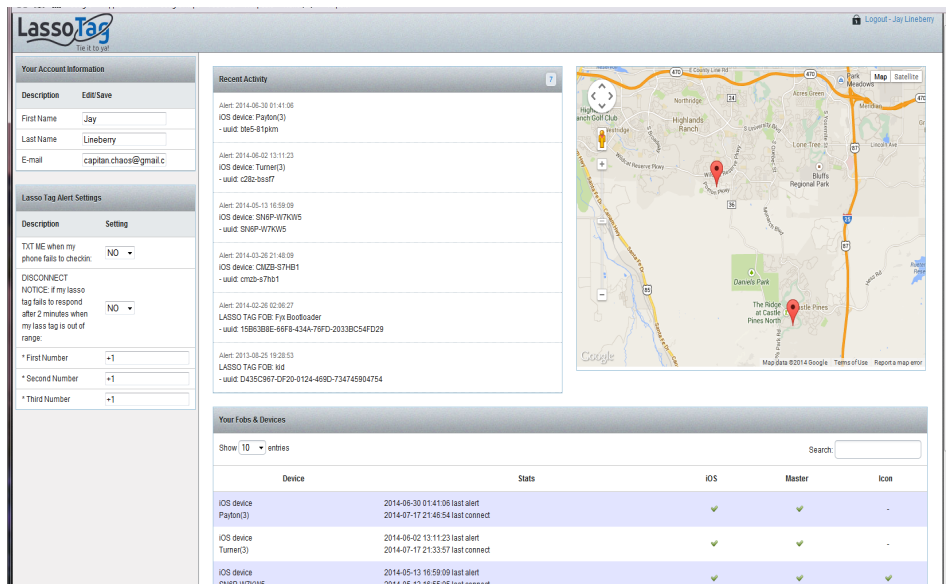
The LassoTag Application comes with 30 Lasso Credits **FREE** to try. \$1.99 will get you 30 additional Lasso Credits. Each Premium Service action costs 1 Lasso Credit. For instance,

iOS Audio/Visual Notification	0 Lasso Credits per action

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Troubleshooting:

1	When Loading an app new release be sure to delete the LassoTag prior releases that may still be installed on your phone.
2	Double Check that you are on the latest release of the Apple iOS operating system
3	Check that Bluetooth is turned on in your phone settings. In some cases, the BlueTooth registry cache needs to be cleaned up. Rebooting the iOS device accomplishes this.
4	The battery in the LassoTag should have the + sign in the up position you will be able to see it before you close the tag.
5	In some rare cases if you are not connected to wifi and the phone signal is weak the tag will not connect. Activate wifi or go to a stronger signal area. This may occur in weak phone signal areas due to when you turn on LassoTag for the first time it needs to send data to the cloud data base.
6	Make sure your location settings are turned on
7	Sometimes you may have to power down your phone and restart it. In extreme cases you can reset the phone under General settings
